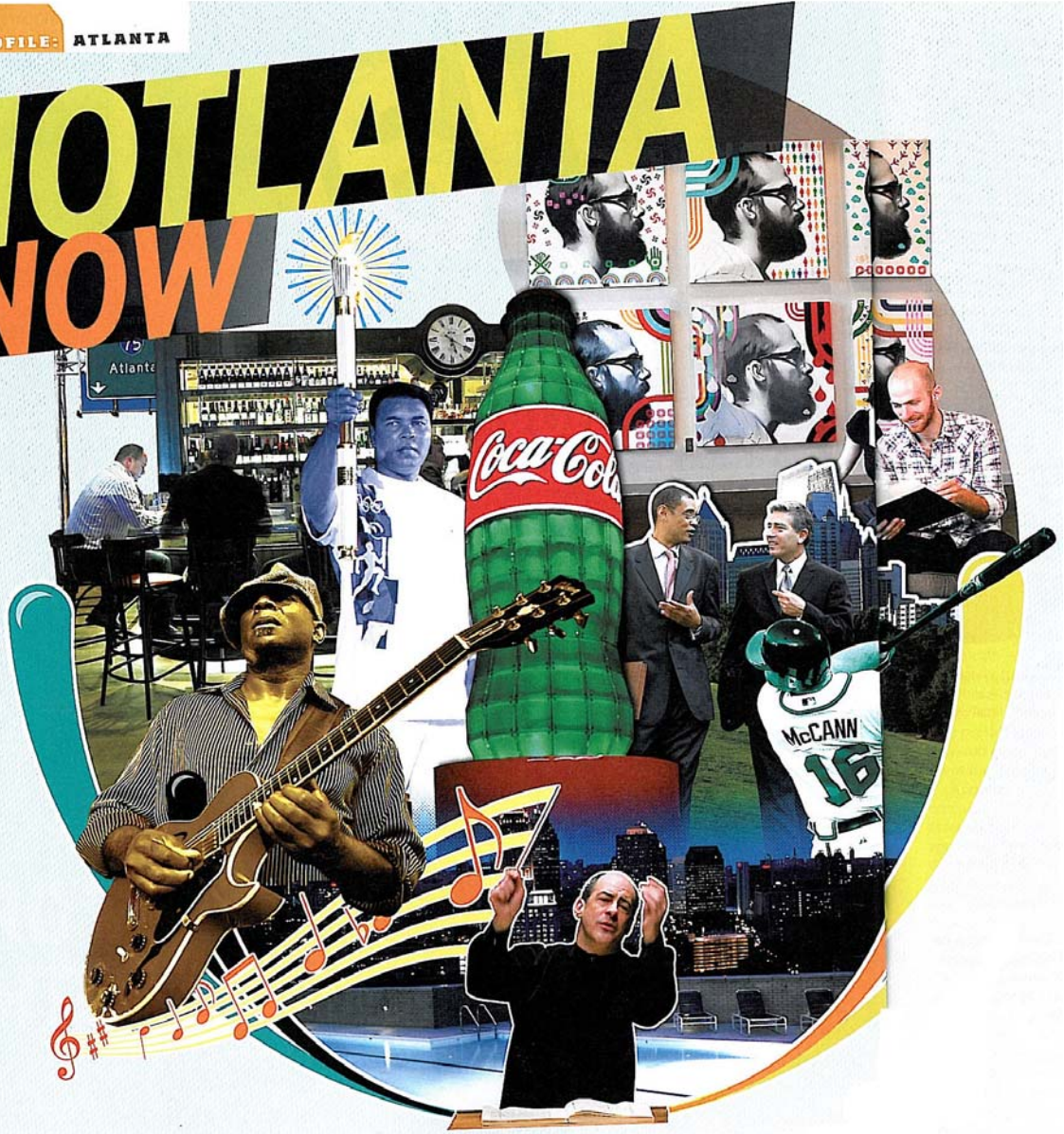

Atlanta's hotel scene has both big traditional chains and a handful of new, smaller boutique properties. In the last few years, W Hotels opened in Downtown, Midtown and Buckhead and Kimpton's Hotel Palomar recently debuted its first property, near the historic Atlanta Biltmore Hotel in Midtown. Many of the new boutique properties—such as Hotel Indigo from the Atlanta-based InterContinental Hotels Group—have become popular for their chic bars and trendy night scenes. **The Vibe:** Sophisticated with a residential feel and a focus on pampering.

**The Crowd:** The St. Regis' location in the heart of upscale Buckhead attracts patrons who like to business and pleasure. Surrounded by corporate offices, the nearby shopping and dining provides a delightful contrast to the business atmosphere.

**The Perks:** Recoup from travel with a Complete Nourishment Facial at Remède Spa or enjoy a good read by the 40,000-square-foot Pool Piazza, complete with a poolside bar and billiards room. The seventh-floor gym is open 24 hours and provides a fitness assistant on request.

**Hot Spot:** A rendezvous spot for the wealthy and working, Paces 88 is a classic American bistro with a professional yet laid-back ambiance that is good for client meetings and happy hours. Dishes include salmon with sweet corn-and-bacon ragout; the beer program focuses on American beers and local microbrews.
